# The Greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven

1At that time the disciples came to Jesus and asked, “Who, then, is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?”

2He called a little child to him, and placed the child among them. 3And he said: “Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. 4Therefore, whoever takes the lowly position of this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. 5And whoever welcomes one such child in my name welcomes me.

## Causing to Stumble

6“If anyone causes one of these little ones—those who believe in me—to stumble, it would be better for them to have a large millstone hung around their neck and to be drowned in the depths of the sea. 7Woe to the world because of the things that cause people to stumble! Such things must come, but woe to the person through whom they come! 8If your hand or your foot causes you to stumble, cut it off and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life maimed or crippled than to have two hands or two feet and be thrown into eternal fire. 9And if your eye causes you to stumble, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to enter life with one eye than to have two eyes and be thrown into the fire of hell.

10“See that you do not despise one of these little ones. For I tell you that their angels in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven. [11] a

12“What do you think? If a man owns a hundred sheep, and one of them wanders away, will he not leave the ninety-nine on the hills and go to look for the one that wandered off? 13And if he finds it, truly I tell you, he is happier about that one sheep than about the ninety-nine that did not wander off. 14In the same way your Father in heaven is not willing that any of these little ones should perish.

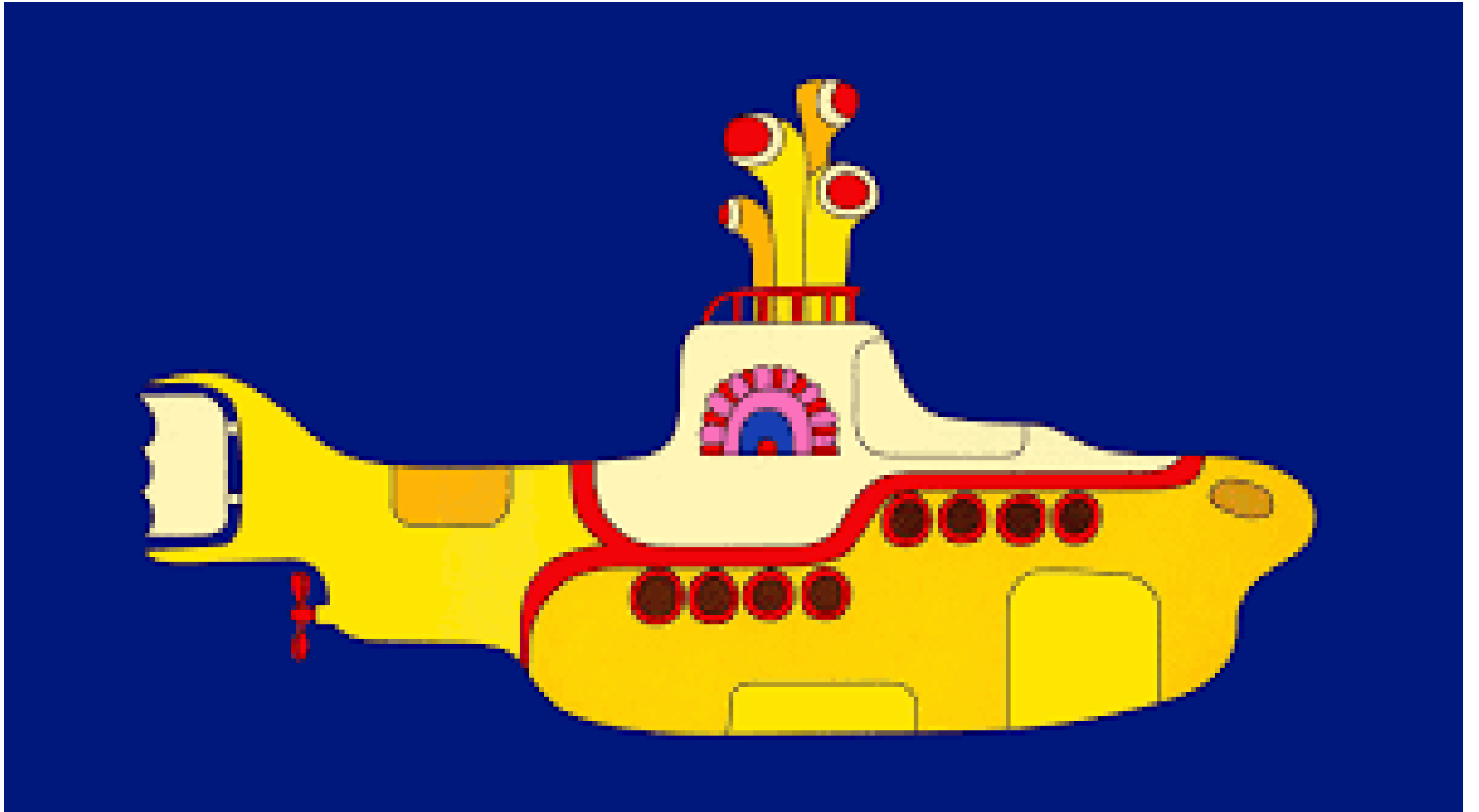

Betray God and you get kicked out of Eden.

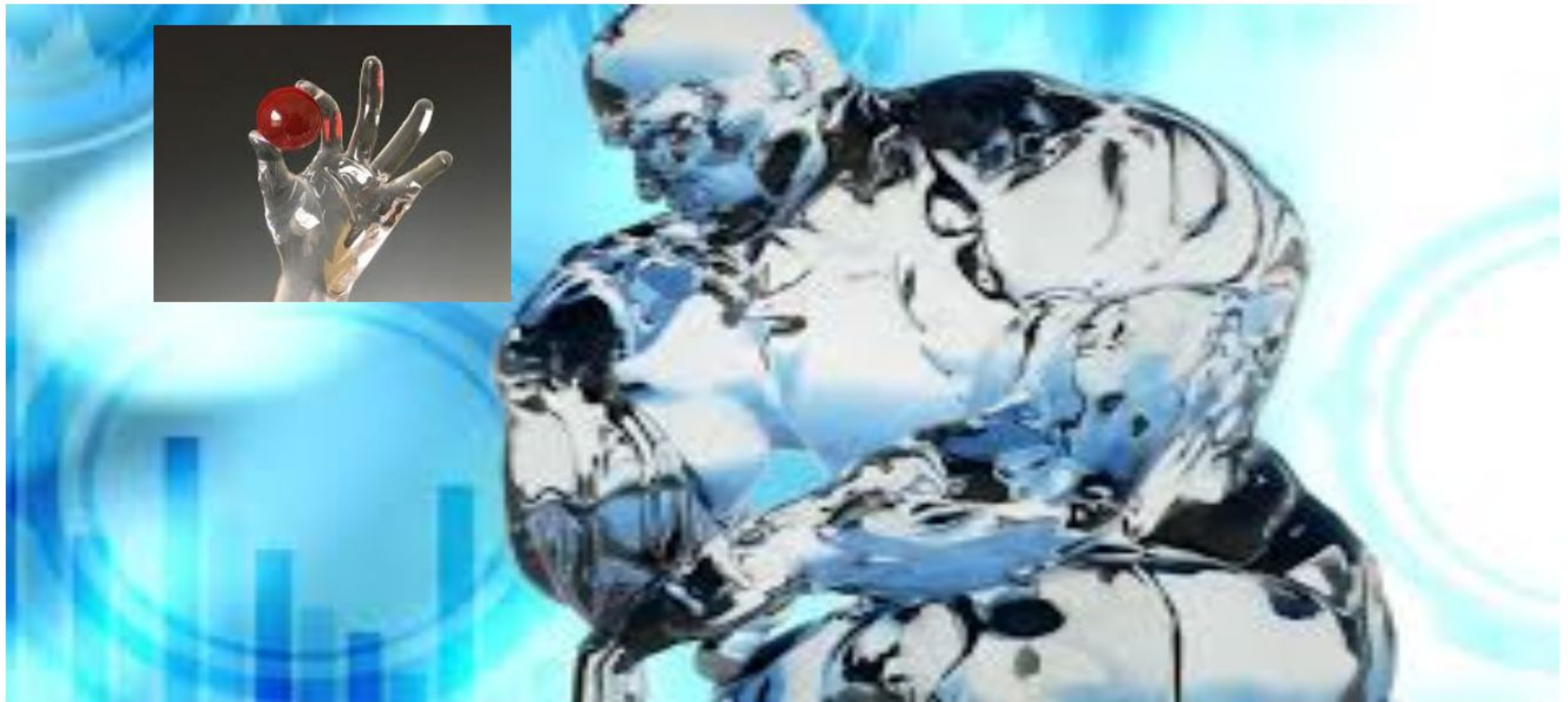
Betrayal is the root of all evil.

to fit on my right shoulder.

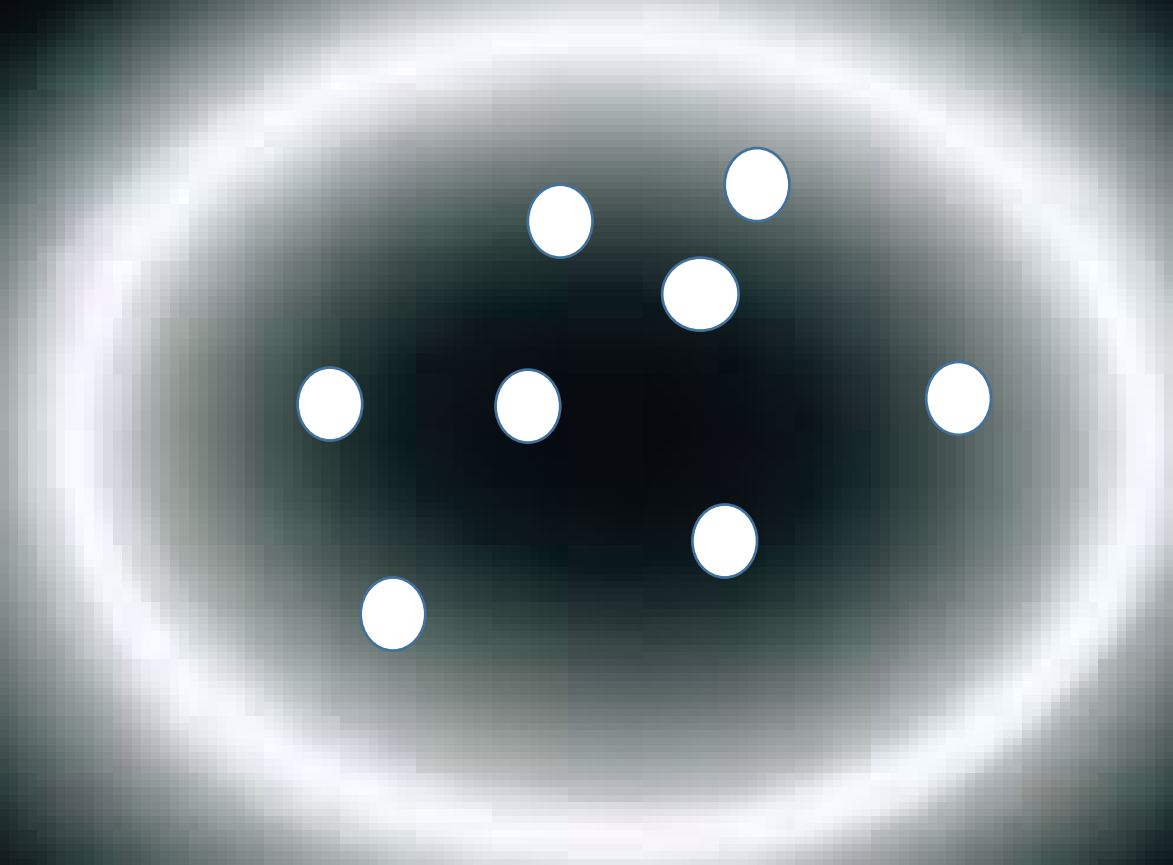






And pulled my soul clean off of my body

one purpose. Showing The way.



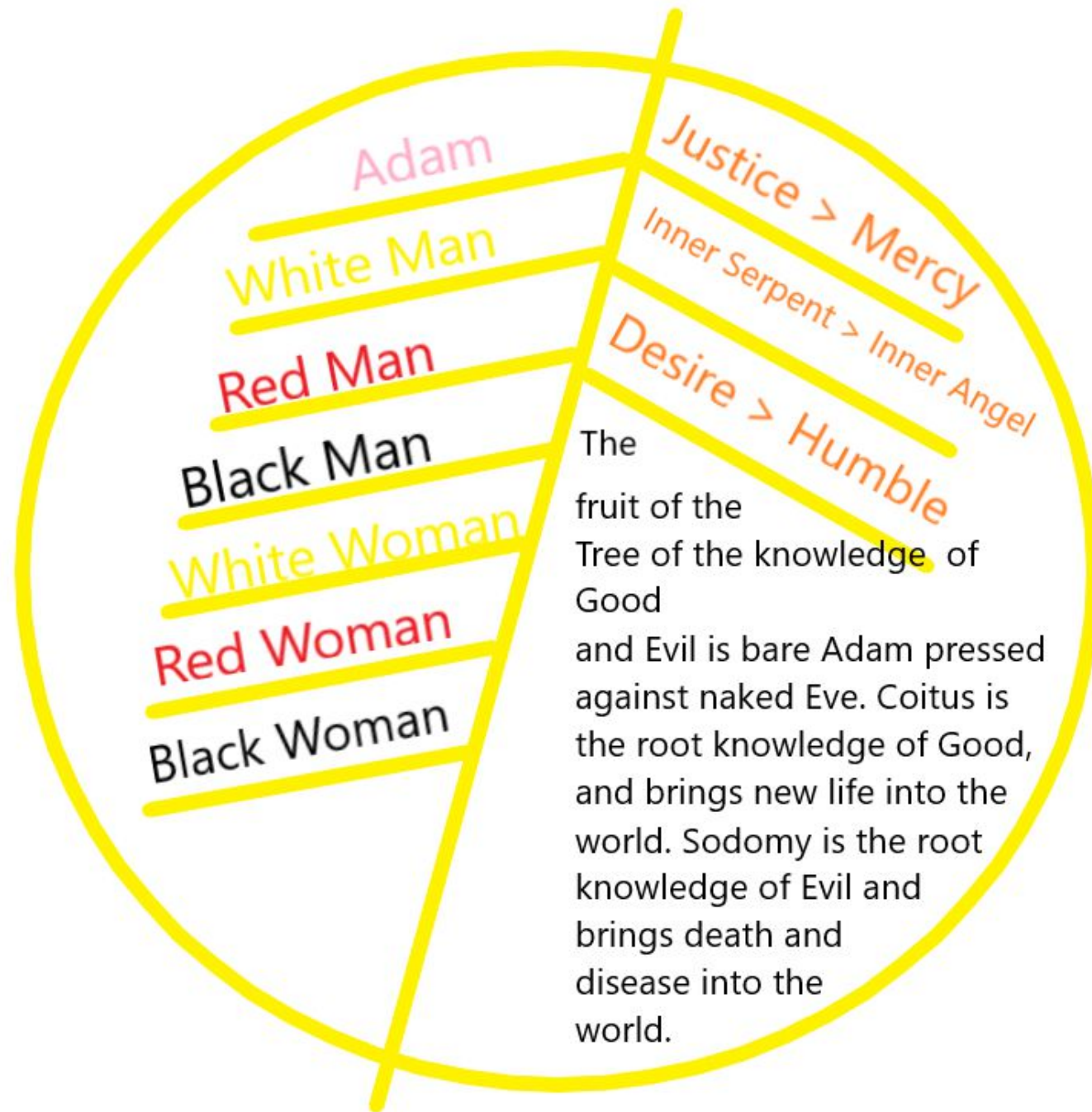
I have already known the statue on the left as “The most ancient” puzzle given to man regarding the signs of ruler ship, the Melchizedek. The King of Salem and the High Priest of God. It is really Shamash and Hammurabi, The King of Babylon.

out.

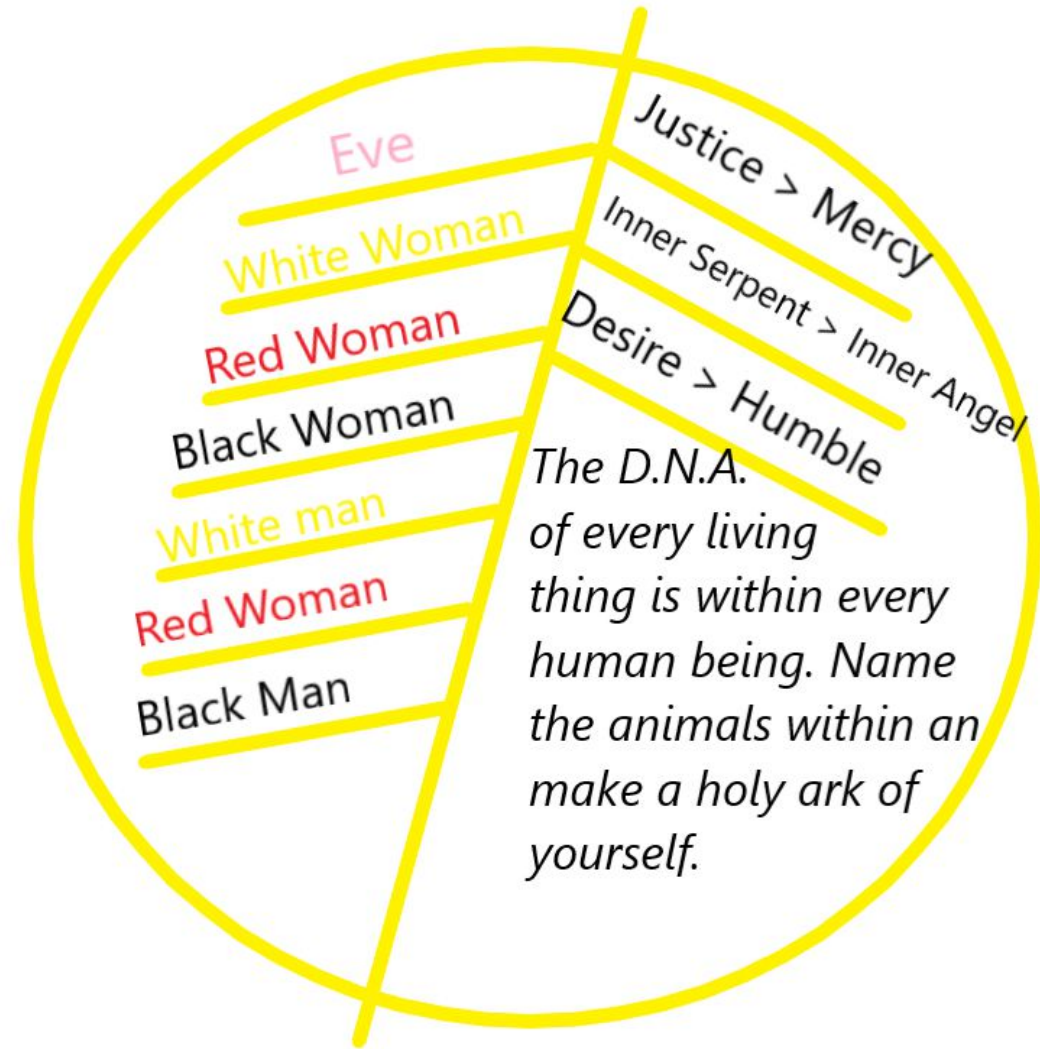
1. Shamash is much larger than his human counterpart.
2. Shamash is seated on a throne that has a serpentine motif.
3. His feet rest upon three rows of thirteen stones.
4. His hat looks like coiled up phallic symbol and he two balls on his neck.
5. There are three ephemeral ribbons streaming up from each shoulder.
6. He is wearing a wrapping, not a robe.
7. He has a beard.
8. He is bare foot.
9. He is offering Hammurabi a circular object and a rod-like object. The circular object looks like a gasket and the rod looks like root.
10. Hammurabi is wearing a helmet, as a king that means he is going to war.
11. Hammurabi is holding his hand against his upset stomach.
12. Hammurabi is holding his hand up to his mouth.
13. He has a beard and is wearing a robe.

The symbols themselves are sex symbols and the authority symbols. The serpent motifs alert you to the environment you are in. The ribbons and the hat remind one of rainbows and the seven-fold spirit of God. The three sets of thirteen seem to be like a counting system. Hammurabi appears to be nauseated by the information and prepared for battle. Using circular logic and going over scriptures I came to this solution. What stimulated this information is that Jesus Christ is depicted as having seven eyes on his head and so does the stone the builders rejected.

As you can see the winged woman has two sets of symbols. They must be for men and women. She is a bird lady with a vagina hat, look at her right ear. She has lion cubs on her feet and is bracketed by owls.
